JYC CRUISING 2011

Over the past few weeks, board members and others have been talking about boating activities for the 2011 season. The following are activities we have proposed and included in the *Hailer* and on our website. As yet, we have not worked out the final details of these activities. Our goal is to finalize the details before the March meeting. We welcome any comments or suggestions you might have, including recommendations for other activities you would like us to consider.

APRIL 30: A “Help Day.” The purpose of the Help Day is for members to help each other with projects that demand additional help in accomplishing, such as removing or installing large batteries. We will be setting up a sign-up list for those requesting help and those that can volunteer their time.

May 7: Shakedown cruise to Taku Harbor. A pot luck dinner on the dock?

There are three summer cruises planned. June and July cruises will be the second Saturday of the month. August’s cruise will be the first weekend. The dates were chosen to avoid conflicts with the major holidays and the Golden North Salmon Derby taking place over the second weekend in August. The locations were chosen to keep travel distances within the cruising abilities of most members and timed to take advantage of fishing opportunities. A potluck dinner will be held on Saturday evenings.

June 11-12: Swanson Harbor and/or Hoonah. We are looking into setting up a special tour of the Icy Point facility with Johan Dybdahl.

July 9: Admiralty Cove. This will be an anchoring event, with raft ups for those that want to do that. Hope for nice weather for a cook out on the beach.

August 6-7: Cruise & Rendezvous St. James Bay. We will select a location in the bay by the March meeting.

We are also pursuing the idea of having a place on our website where members can post their own cruising plans they would like to share with other club members. The hope is that folks can link up for a more safe and worry free experience.
