Community Taxing Structure on Boats, by Reported Location –

Homer: Vessels 20' and over located within the city limits of Homer are taxed according to the city's flat tax schedule in addition to the Kenai Peninsula Borough flat tax.

Kenai Peninsula Borough Watercraft Flat Tax Schedule

Less than 15 ft \$0
15 to less than 20 ft \$0
20 to less than 25 ft \$50
25 to less than 36 ft \$150
36 to less than 60 ft \$250
60 to less than 100 ft \$500
100 or more ft in length \$1,000

Homer Watercraft Flat Tax Schedule

Less than 15 ft \$0
15 to less than 20 ft \$0
20 to less than 25 ft \$10
25 to less than 36 ft \$30
36 to less than 60 ft \$50
60 to less than 100 ft \$100
100 or more ft in length \$200



NAUTICAL TID-BITS

"Ahoy!" - This old traditional greeting for hailing other vessels was originally a Viking battle cry.

Unalaska: Exempts vessels from property tax.

Petersburg: They do not tax boats and the City Manager was unaware of any issues concerning school funding by not taxing boats.

Pelican: The City of Pelican has a \$20.00 property tax per vessel.

Sitka: The following is Sitka's tax as it stands on the books. However, the tax is not rigorously implemented. Also, Sitka's harbor system is highly subsidized with general funds from the municipality, unlike Juneau.

All boats and vessels located within the boundaries of the city and borough on January 1st of any given year shall be subject to taxation under the same procedures and with the same assessment dates and due dates as personal property, except that valuation and taxation shall be on the basis of registered and certified length according to the schedule set forth below:

- Class 1 Less than 15 feet in length \$20.00
- Class 2 15 to less than 20 feet in length \$30.00
- Class 3 20 to less than 30 feet in length \$50.00
- Class 4 30 to less than 50 feet in length \$100.00
- Class 5 50 or more feet in length \$200.00

Ketchikan: The Borough Assembly classifies boats twelve (12) feet or more in overall length for the purpose of taxation and establishes the assessed valuation of such boats and vessels on the basis of their registered or certified net tonnage.

The tax on boats twelve (12) feet or more in overall length shall be:

- Twenty-five dollars (\$25) per year for boat or vessel of five (5) net tons or less;
- Seventy-five dollars (\$75) a year for a boat or vessel of more than five (5) net tons.
