Increasing membership remains one of my central goals for 2006. Please share with your friends what the Juneau Yacht Club is doing in our community; then invite them to an activity and to join our club. Sponsoring a **Marine Safety Day** is just one more service that JYC provides to our community.

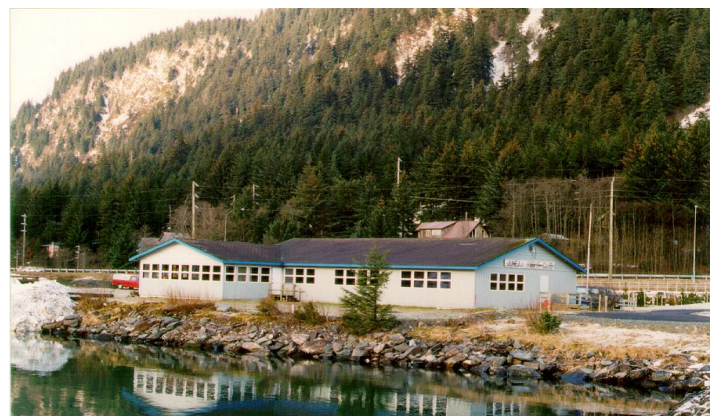
