- We were once again a primary sponsor to Juneau Youth Sailing, Inc. About 100 youth and adult sailors were trained this year; gaining skills that will last them a lifetime.
- We conducted an active sailing schedule. Races included the Juneau Cup series which were held from May to September and the Around Admiralty Island Race in June. (David Carnes, Sailing Fleet Captain, did an outstanding job to lead this effort.)
- We provided vessels and crews to patrol local waters during the Golden North Salmon Derby. (Tom Satre, Past Commodore, led this endeavor).
- We supported the Christmas Food Box event that provides food for needy families. (Members Laraine Derr and Rita Hamilton kept this before us).
- We participated in this year's 'Toys for Tots' program conducted by the U.S. Coast Guard. We collected and delivered 20 Christmas toys which will be distributed to needy families with children in our local area.

Roll Call (Establish Quorum) Seven of eight members present.

Insurance review: The board reviewed our current insurance policy with insurance agent, Teresa Young of Shattuck & Grummett to determine if we are adequately covered. Coverage concerns were expressed to make sure our coverage covers club-sponsored events and board member liability. Teresa is researching our questions and the Commodore will complete an application for board member liability. The board thanked JYC members J. Mahan and M. Rental for attending to answer questions and to hear their concerns about club-sponsored event coverage. Status: open.

JYC annual dues: A motion was M/S/P to keep 2007 dues at \$50 per adult member.

Treasurer’s report: Approximately \$16,000 is in our account. All bills are current. Annual insurance premium is due mid-December.

Financial review: The board received from the treasurer an income/expense comparison sheet for 2005 and 2006. A draft 2007 budget was developed.
